A-Z useful information

Accommodation

Accommodation is not included as part of your delegate package and if required will need to be booked separately. Please contact the Novotel directly to arrange this. *Please note:* There are no special event rates or rooms reserved for the event, we encourage delegates to book early to avoid disappointment.

Cashpoint

The closest Cashpoint can be found within walking distance on Broad Street.

Cloakroom

The cloakroom will be located in the Bourneville Suite, where a coat rack will be available for our event only. Information and directions will be given at registration.

Disabled access and facilities

Disabled access is easiest via the main reception door located on ground level at the front of the building. However, if coming from the hotel car park access is a bit more Complicated, one has to enter via the service lift from the underground parking and then go to the first floor, then across the corridor and down again in the main lift to the ground floor reception. Please do let us know if you have any disabled requirements and we will ensure someone is there to accompany you to registration or reception. Toilets with disabled access are found on the ground floor outside the main meeting room (Priestley/Darwin/Wedgwood Suite), just past registration.

Dress code

Travel information

Directions by Car: Exit the M6 at junction 6 and follow the A38(M) towards Birmingham(E&C). Continue onto the Aston Express Way/A38, keep right to continue on Queensway/A38, keep right to continue on Great Charles Street Queensway/A38, take the exit towards New Street, continue onto Suffolk Street Queensway, at the roundabout, take the 3rd exit onto Holloway Head/B4127, turn right onto Granville St. Guests can drive to the main door of the hotel at 70 Broad Street where there is a limited number of car parking spaces for hotel guests (no prior reservations required). Other car parks are located close by.

Directions by Bus: Some bus routes run through Broad Street and can reach the main door of the hotel. To check routes and numbers please visit https://nxbus.co.uk/west-midlands/

Directions by Rail: The nearest main train station is Birmingham New Street. The tram system runs from New Street station to Broad Street and takes around 10 minutes, this can also be walked in around 16 minutes. A taxi will take 5 minutes and bus 11 minutes. Snowhill train station is also around a 20-minute walk, 8 minutes by bus and 4 minutes by taxi.
